MEETING TOPIC: *Hybridizing For Beginners ~ Goals, Techniques & Results*

Answers to questions such as "How do I pick good parents for my crosses?", or "How do I save pollen?" will be answered. MARCH MEETING

For our March meeting, Nan Ray will lead a discussion about why certain rhododendrons just don't perform (grow, bloom) as they're supposed to. Please bring in a list of your 5 "worst performer" loser plants. We'll compare notes to see if failure is because of us or the plant.

We'll also have a local landscaper - whose specialty is pruning – demonstrate how to properly and aesthetically prune Japanese Maples. He will also talk about pruning in general and touch on pruning of rhododendrons.

SHOW & TELL

Do you have a "Seta", "Noyo Dream" "Cornubia", "Crysodorum" or other early blooming rhododendron and azalea blooming in your garden now? If so, bring in a truss to share, so the rest of us can be inspired to grow early bloomers too.

MAINTENANCE

Our speaker, Don Wallace suggests feeding your rhodies in mid Feb (like now) and again in mid June. If you're going to feed your plants now, use fertilizer with a high "P" (NPK) value for big blooms. Don also suggests using fish emulsion or liquid kelp for foliar feeding on a monthly basis. Think about adding some early blooming or late blooming rhodies to your collection to extend your enjoyment of the bloom season.
