## MAINTENANCE

More on fertilizer: Don Wallace, of Singing Tree Nursery printed a recipe for "home made" rhododendron fertilizer in his Oct 2009 newsletter, I don't think he'll mind if I post it here:  
(you can buy these ingredients "in bulk" @ Common Ground in Palo Alto)

### Home-Made Fall Fertilizer

- 1 part rock phosphate (or triple phosphate) for healthier roots, stems, and leaves
- 1 part Kelp meal for disease resistance, and many trace elements that boost plant health
- 1/2 part Alfalfa meal for plant vigor, this will help the plant fend off diseases and insects.
- 1 part dolomite for magnesium and ph adjustment of very acid conditions
- 1/2 part greensand to give your plants better moisture retention in cold, drying winds.
