Don Wallace of Singing Tree Gardens, this month's speaker suggests feeding your plants at the end of Jan or beginning of Feb (he does it around Valentine's Day) with a high phosphorus fertilizer (high middle number in the NPK formula) for bigger, more colorful flowers.
